What to expect

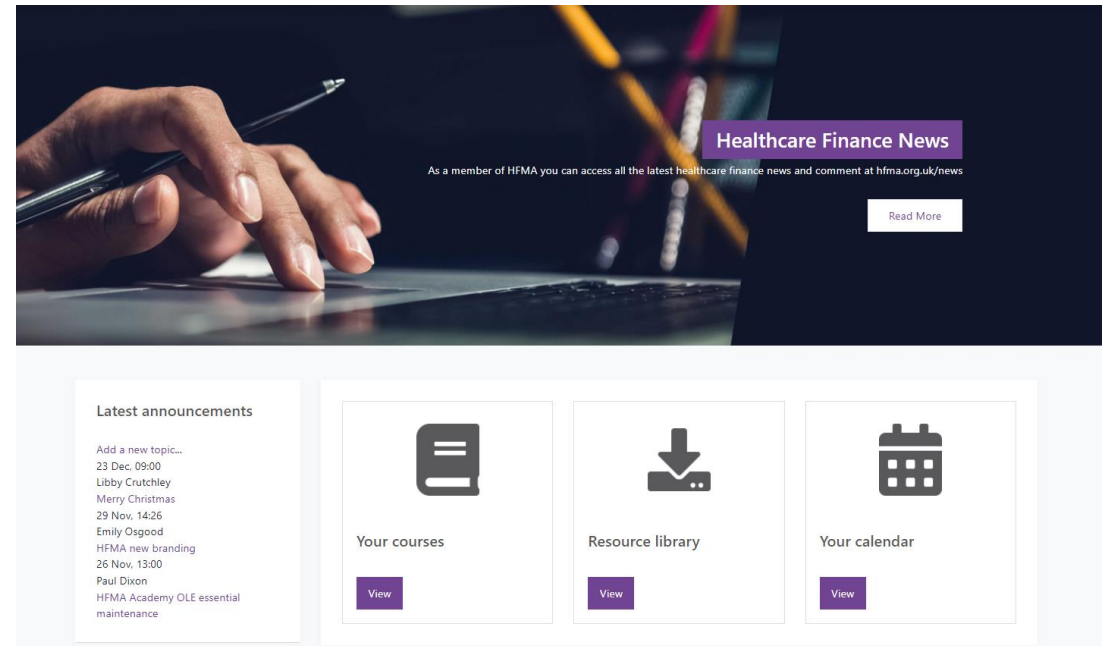
Course structure:
