Health Expenditure Benchmarking development

- The NHS England Costing team have reestablished programme budgeting (PB), reinventing it as Health Expenditure Benchmarking (HEB) as a lower burden source of whole system cost analysis
- Differences between PB and HEB PB based on CCG/PCT data, HEB based on NCC PLICS and aggregate data
- It gives systems and providers the chance to identify and analyse their costs across the system
- It allows for benchmarking against peers
- Recognising data gaps and limitations, we have processed data from 2019/20 and 2020/21 NCC PLICS/reference costs





PB compared to HEB process





How HEB works

CCG/ICB code

- Check NCC PLICS data for CCG/ICB code (for 2022/23 onwards)
- Match NCC PLICS to dataset for CCG/ICB code (including check for trust and CCG mergers)
- If neither present allocate to CCG/ICB based on provider contract schedule

Condition category

- Match NCC PLICS dataset for condition codes
- Unmatched or unavailable costs assigned to 23X Other

Additional costs

- BSA Prescribing schedule split by condition and CCG
- CCG accounts expenditure values allocated to CCGs 2020/21 (no condition information available at present)

National Category Unit Cost	This is the average cost of any particular HEB Category for the whole dataset	Sum(TotalCost) / Sum(TotalActivity)
Over Or Under National Category Unit Cost	This is the difference between National Category Unit Cost and HEB Category Unit Cost: Over: The cost for any selection is higher than the National Average Under: The cost for any selection is lower than the National Average	HEB Category Unit Cost - National Category Unit Cost
Cost per 100,000 Population	This measure shows the cost per 100,000 in any particular CCG	Cost per 100,000 Population = Total Cost/Population Size * 100,000


Chart - Total Cost by Commissioner





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Chart - Category Unit Cost



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
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

Data quality & completeness

What can trusts do to help?

Organisation Identifier (Code of commissioner)

- No need to match / link NCC PLICS to dataset
- Quick mapping to ICB

Quality of Linking / Matching fields

- Better condition records
- Fewer unknown condition records
- Better matching to ICB/CCG codes
